



AUSTRALIAN FIRE & FIRST AID

EVACUATION/INVACUATION TRAINING

DESCRIPTION

This training is suitable for companies and organisations which are required to have staff trained as wardens. This course shows wardens how to evacuate or lock down (invacuation) a premises in emergency situations.

PREREQUISITES

There are no prerequisites for this training.

DURATION

1 hour classroom training and assessment.

ASSESSMENT METHOD

Progressive assessment throughout the course, including oral questions and practical assessment via emergency drill

COURSE CONTENT

- + Identify emergency type and assess need to evacuate or invacuate
- + Thorough visual and audio sweeping and searching techniques
- + identification of potential hazards during emergencies
- + Human behavior in emergency situations
- + Walk through and evaluation of site exits and assembly point
- + Effective communication with emergency services personnel
- + Documentation and reporting of incidents according to workplace procedures
- + Practical exercise debrief meeting
- + Written exercise report for tabling at next ECO (OHS) meeting

OTHER

+ This course will ensure a workplace meets their requirement to undergo 'at least one evacuation procedure in every 12 month period' as per Australian Standard 3745-2010. Award is issued to the organisation not individual participants.
