



AUSTRALIAN FIRE & FIRST AID

PROVIDE FIRST AID– (formerly apply/senior first aid)

DESCRIPTION

This unit of competency describes the skills and knowledge required to provide first aid response, life support, management of casualty(s), the incident and other first aiders, until the arrival of medical or other assistance.

PREREQUISITES

Students must have adequate numeracy and literacy skills to complete assessment.

DURATION

14 hours (2 days) for total face-to-face program OR Combined 6 hours practical training and assessment, theory component is undertaken via the internet in students own time. Must be completed before practical assessment commences.

ASSESSMENT METHOD

Progressive assessment throughout the course, including demonstration of practical skills, written and oral questions relating to underpinning knowledge.

COURSE CONTENT

- + Assessing an emergency situation
- + Airway and breathing management
- + Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation techniques (CPR)
- + First Aid management of the unconscious casualty
- + Management of heart conditions
- + Infection control and First Aid for minor wounds
- + Allergic reactions and asthma
- + Control of external bleeding and shock
- + Management of near drowning + Hyperthermia and hypothermia
- + Burns and electric shock + Eye and soft tissue injuries
- + Venomous bites and stings + Fractures and spinal injuries
- + Head, chest and abdominal injuries
- + Assessment and movement of the sick and injured
- + Communicating details of an incident & Recording vital signs
- + Debriefing and evaluation of response to critical incidents knowledge.
